

A NEW LOOK AT WEATHERIZATION



Weatherization is not new. COAD and Community Action have been weatherizing homes through programs such as the Ohio Department of Development's Home Weatherization Assistance Program (HWAP) and Columbia Gas of Ohio's WarmChoice® for over 30 years.

What's new about this program is how we're doing it. Previously, the program worked house by house, jumping from town to town across the region. That wastes time and energy—crews have to pack up their equipment and drive to another community, then unpack and start over, rather than just walk next door and start on the next house. Folks on the waiting list might see their neighbors get services long before they did. Now, a whole neighborhood will be weatherized within a few months.

This approach has already generated a lot of excitement. We hope you're excited too, and look forward to working with you to make your home more comfortable and energy-efficient.



In addition to weatherizing individual homes, we are also working with a number of businesses and funders to meet other community needs. Last spring, you helped identify Murray City's priorities through community surveys and public meetings, and we want to help you accomplish some of those goals. The attention generated from this weatherization project may help us get new playground equipment, improve ADA accessibility for the Senior Center, and may even help us reopen the community center.

- A free home energy audit.
- Safety check of gas appliances
- Energy Efficient light-bulbs

YOU MAY ALSO QUALIFY FOR

- Free or rebated Weatherization
 - Air sealing to reduce infiltration
 - Attic and Wall insulation
 - Floor insulation
 - Pipe and/or duct insulation
- Shower head replacement
- Refrigeration replacement
- Furnace replacement
- Hot water heater replacement.

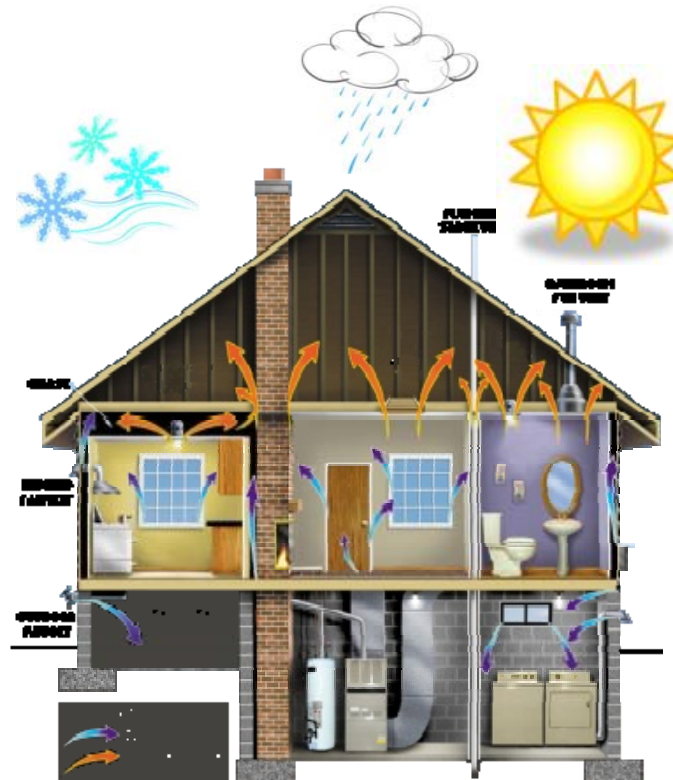
WHAT DOES IT COST?

Nothing. Everyone receives a free energy audit, and based on your household income, we'll let you know what else you can get for free.

WHY WEATHERIZE?

Weatherization helps keep your home more comfortable—warmer in the winter and cooler in the summer. Air sealing reduces drafts, insulation reduces heat transfer between inside and out, and safety inspections of your gas appliances mean increased safety for you and your family.

The rest of the energy audit evaluates your electric usage. You'll get energy saving light bulbs, and you may also qualify for an Energy Star appliance. Together, these services help reduce your energy bills.

HOW DO I QUALIFY?

To receive your free energy audit and determine your eligibility for other services, we will need:

- A completed application: ALL pages filled out completely and signed.
- Proof of residence: Your property deed, a copy of your mobile home title (if not registered as real estate), rental agreement (if you rent), and/or a copy of your recorded land contract.
- A copy of your GAS and ELECTRIC bills
- Proof of income for ALL household members for the past 12 months.

Based on this information, we'll determine which programs you're eligible for and get you scheduled for your energy audit!
